IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION FOR) CREATION OF A FLOOD CONTROL DIS-) TRICT ON THE BOISE RIVER IN ADA) AND CANYON COUNTIES, IDAHO)

Order Creating Flood Control District No. 10 of Idaho

WHEREAS, Albert Wolfkiel, et al, have heretofore petitioned the Director of the Department of Water Administration, in accordance with the provisions of Title 42, Chapter 31, <u>Idaho Code</u>, for the formation of Flood Control District No. 10 of the State of Idaho, said petition proposing inclusion of approximately 25,000 acres of land located in Ada and Canyon Counties, Idaho, and it appearing that the petitioners represent more than one-third of the taxable area in the proposed Flood Control District, to wit: approximately 9,247.64 acres or 37% of the taxable area; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Water Administration has considered the said petition and matters related thereto as is required of him by Title 42, Chapter 31, <u>Idaho Code</u>, and has consulted with the land owners, and interested local, state, and federal organizations and individuals and has made a physical inspection of the area; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Water Administration upon presentation of the petition of Albert Wolfkiel, et al, gave notice of the hearing on said petition on the 14th of July 1970, by advertising said notice in the Idaho Daily Statesman, Boise, Idaho on each of the following dates: June 29, July 6, and July 13 and in the News-Tribume, Caldwell, Idaho on each of the following dates: June 27, July 3, and July 11 and on the 27th day of June 1970, placed a map of the proposed Flood Control District No. 10 of Idaho on file in the offices of the county recorder, the county assessor, and with the county commissioners of Ada and Canyon Counties, Idaho; and,

WHEREAS, a hearing was held in the State Office Building, the place assigned in said notice, at the hour of 1:00 p.m., on the 14th day of July 1970, at which time the Director of the Department of Water Administration heard any and all persons, corporations and organizations interested in the formation of the proposed Flood Control District and heard any and all persons, corporations and organizations objecting to the formation of said Flood Control District; and,

and that the appointed commissioners are hereby required to qualify the same as county officials, by taking an oath and each giving of a bond to the State of Idaho for the benefit of Flood Control District No. 10 of Idaho, in the amount of \$5,000.00, or such sum as the judge of the district court may provide, and upon the giving of said bond, shall be entitled to enter upon the duties of Commissioners of said Flood Control District No. 10 of Idaho and shall hold office for the terms of one, two, or three years as determined by lot or until their successors shall have been appointed and qualified;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appointed commissioners shall meet immediately after their bonds shall have been filed with the clerk of the District Court and shall organize themselves into a Board;

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Water Administration finds that the formation of Flood Control District No. 10 is necessary, practicable and feasible, in order to provide control of the Boise River and its tributaries in the affected area to protect life and property, preserve the public health and welfare and conserve and develop the natural resources of the State of Idaho, and that formation of Flood Control District No. 10 is a proper and advantageous method of obtaining the relief sought and securing the desired benefits; and,

WHEREAS, as a result of the hearing, the boundaries of said district were fixed and the district was divided into three divisions, all of which more particularly appear on the map attached hereto marked as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as fully as if described particularly herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is the order of the Director of Department of Water Administration of the State of Idaho that Flood Control District No. 10 of Idaho, the boundaries of which are more particularly described as follows, to wit:
